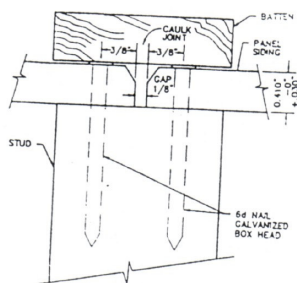
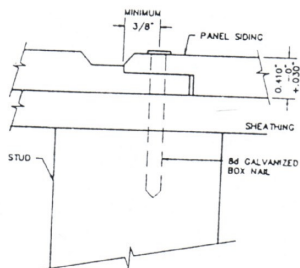


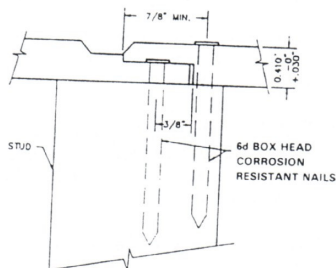
DRAWING 6A

VERTICAL BUTT JOINTS



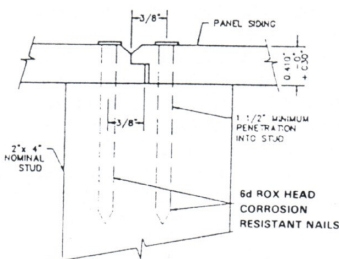
DRAWING 6B

LIMITED WARRANTY

Temple-Inland Forest Products Corporation warrants to the original owner that its hardboard siding sub will be free from defects in materials and workmanship, and will comply with the Voluntary Product Standard which is in effect at the time of manufacture, and such warranty will be valid for a period of twenty-five years. Should the product be found not to comply with this warranty at any time within twenty-five (25) years from date of installation, Temple-Inland will issue a cash refund for a prorated portion of the purchase price of the defective siding.

Temple-Inland further warrants that the factory applied primer or prefinish will not peel, crack or blister under normal conditions of use or exposure for a period of five (5) years from the date of original installation. Should the factory finish fail under this warranty, Temple-Inland will compensate the original owner in cash for the material and labor required to refinish the siding with one coat of acrylic latex housepaint.

Any claim must be made in writing to Temple-Inland Forest Products Corporation at P.O. Drawer N, Diboll, Texas 75941, within sixty (60) days after discovery of any defect and before alterations are made. Temple-Inland must be given a reasonable time to investigate the claim before any alterations are made.

This warranty is effective only if the siding is handled, stored, applied, finished, used, and maintained according to Temple-Inland's application instructions, and in accordance with good standards of practice within the building industry. This warranty does not apply where siding is used for trim strips, fascia, mansards or skirting. This warranty is not effective when the siding is subjected to unusual physical impact, abrasion, abuse, neglect, prolonged contact with accumulated water, moisture condensation in the wall cavity, nor is this warranty effective when there is a failure to provide reasonable and necessary maintenance, including recaulking, repainting, or other normal weather protection. Temple-Inland will not be responsible for the unsatisfactory performance of its siding or for damaged siding that is caused by others not under the control of Temple-Inland.

Temple-Inland shall not be liable for incidental, indirect, special, or consequential damages arising from any breach of this warranty. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitations of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.

The duration of any implied warranty shall be the same as that of the express warranty. Some states do not allow limitations on how long an implied warranty lasts, so the above limitations may not apply to you.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
